Background

Sub-section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the ACT Remuneration Tribunal (the Tribunal) to inquire into, and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements of the holders of any position or appointment notified in writing to the Tribunal by the Chief Minister.

The Chief Minister has referred the Victims of Crime Commissioner to the Tribunal for such determination.

Tribunal Consideration

The Commissioner is a full-time statutory position established under the *Victims of Crime Amendment Act 2010*. The legislation operates on and from 28 February 2011.

It is intended that the office will replace the existing statutory offices of Victims of Crime Coordinator and Domestic Violence Project Coordinator.

The Tribunal considered the report of an independent review of the role and responsibilities undertaken by Mercer. Mercer assessed the office as aligning with the executive 1.1 level in the ACT Public Service.

The Tribunal also considered a further submission made to it about the role and responsibilities of the office.

The Tribunal determined that the office be paid a salary of \$126,302 per annum from 28 February 2011

The Tribunal determines as follows:

Pursuant to section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to the person holding the full-time public office of Victims of Crime Commissioner and determines as follows: -

1. Remuneration of \$126,302 per annum.
2. Determination 3 of 2010 – ‘Full-time Holders of Public Office’ made on 16 June 2010 is varied by :
 - a. inserting “Victims of Crime Commissioner” and \$126,302 in Columns 1 and 2 respectively in Table 1.1; and
 - b. inserting “Victims of Crime Commissioner” in Clause 4 of Schedule A – “Definitions”.
3. Relevant economy or business class travel for the purposes of Clause 4 and 4 star accommodation for the purposes of Clause 6 of Determination 16 of 2007 – ‘Travel allowances for Full-time and Part-time Holders of Public Office’.
4. Schedule A to Determination 16 of 2007 be amended by inserting “Victims of Crime Commissioner” with Full-time Office Holders.
5. This Determination shall take effect from 28 February 2011.
