



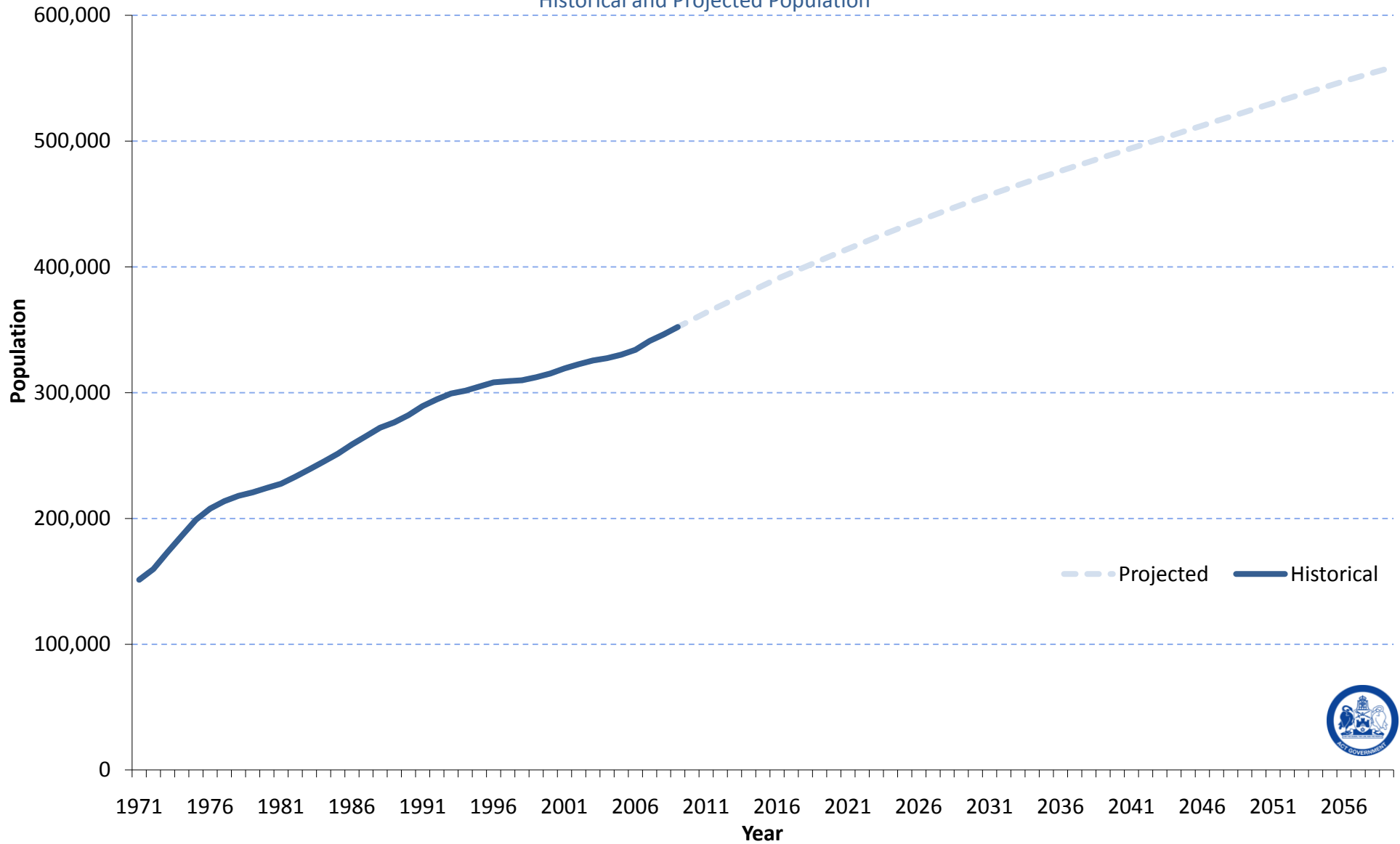

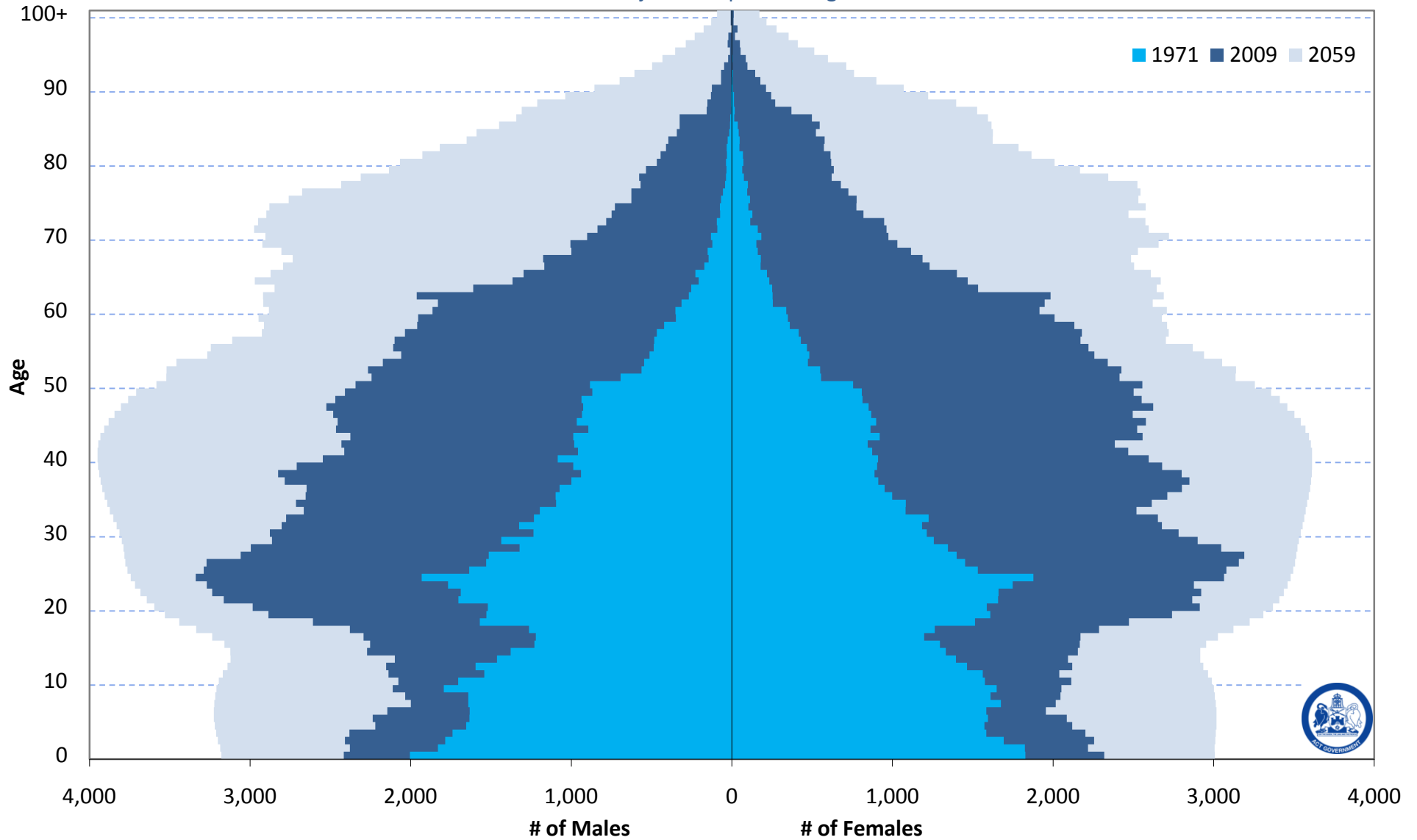

Historical and Projected Population



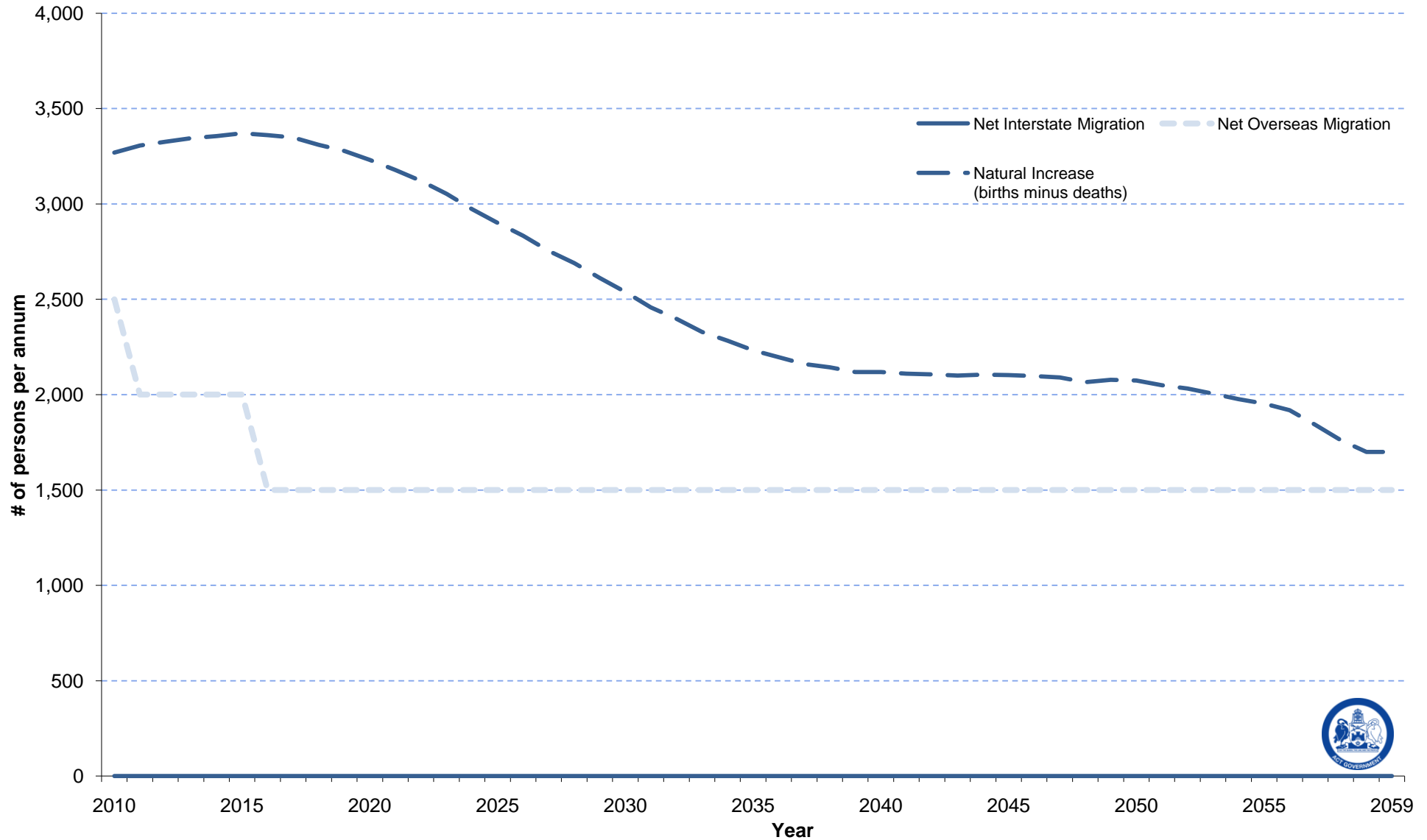
